DUES STRUCTURE

Minimum standard dues are \$1,600.00 per year in addition to a one-time contribution to the Operating Endowment Fund \$1,500.00. For those members who are 35 years of age or under, the minimum standard dues are \$800.00 per year, and the Endowment Fund contribution of \$1,500.00 may be delayed until they turn 36. There are no other assessments billed to our congregants, with the exception of fees for the Religious School.

The Beth-El Sanctuary Circle is available to members who are capable of contributing above the standard dues level. Attached is a list of the Sanctuary Circle giving levels. These contributions are directed to the General Fund to defray any potential shortfall created by members who are unable to pay full dues.

The dues payment, **MADE PAYABLE TO BETH-EL CONGREGATION**, should accompany the application for membership. The payment may be in the amount of one quarter, \$400.00, or for the full year of \$1,600.00. For those members who are under 36 years of age, the payment may be in the amount of one quarter, \$200.00, or for the full year of \$800.00. For convenience purposes Beth-El Congregation accepts American Express, MasterCard and Visa. The Operating Endowment Fund contribution of \$1,500.00 may be paid within a three-year period, or is reduced to only \$1,200.00 if paid in its entirety when you join.

Statements are sent to congregants on the following dates:

December 15	(Dues for 1/1 – 3/31)
March 15	(Dues for 4/1/ - 6/30)
June 15	(Dues for 7/1 – 9/30)
September 15	(Dues for 10/1 – 12/31)

DUES payments are DUE on the BEGINNING DAY of the billing quarter.

The Temple Board's policy is that a "Member in Good Standing" is one who complies with the above dues payment policy. Anyone who is more than two quarters in arrears will be subject to review by the Board of Directors concerning possible cancellation of membership.
