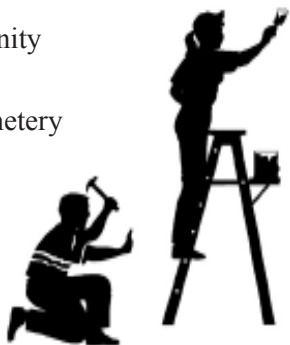
It begins at **9:00 AM** with breakfast in the Great Hall, followed by a short service at 9:30.
